Dear Grade 10-12 Students and Parents/Guardians:

Welcome *back* to Nepean High School and to our new students, welcome *to* Nepean.

Between Wednesday, August 26th and Friday, August 28th, all students are asked to drop in at Nepean High School between 8:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. to:

- pick up your 2009/2010 timetable and student planner,
- deal with any outstanding textbook liabilities,
- return your Media Permission Form,
- pay your Student Activity Fee \$30.00 (please see attached memo).

Any student unable to pick up their timetable in this format will need to line up in the Main Office on the first day of school to pay their Student Activity Fee, receive their timetable and deal with any outstanding textbook liabilities. Accordingly, please make every effort to come in the week before to ensure an effortless first day of school!

On **Tuesday, September 1st, 2009**, a modified school day will begin at 9:30 a.m. We will run all four periods in a shortened Day 1 format (1, 2, 3, 4); ending at 11:45 a.m. Students will meet their teachers and receive course outlines and evaluation procedures. Students are asked to bring a secure lock on September 1st to install on their assigned locker. It is essential that students occupy the locker which they are assigned. They are responsible for their designated locker and therefore should not share their locker.

Nepean High School has an automatic messaging system that will alert parents to absences, lates and other important information. Should you be late for class, you will report directly to class. Attendance will be monitored by the teachers and the office. Parents are advised to ensure that the school has a current phone number and e-mail address to which the system is able to forward information as needed.

Wednesday, September 2nd will be a regular full school day beginning at 9:05 a.m., following a Day 2 schedule.
